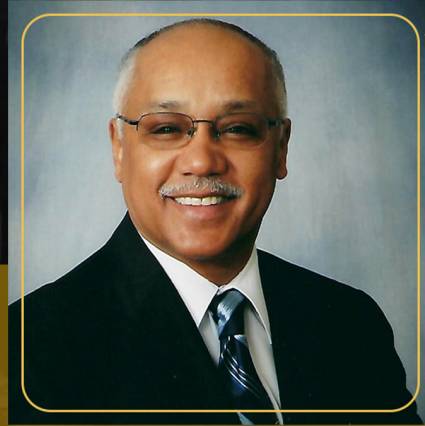


# DISTINGUISHED FRATERNAL SERVICE AWARD

He holds a Master of Science in Dental Public Health from Boston University, Goldman School of Dental Medicine. He completed his Doctor of Dental Surgery in 1981 from the prestigious Dental School at Meharry Medical College in Nashville, TN. Dr. Enos further honed his skills through a General Practice Residency Program at Boston City Hospital in 1982. His academic journey began with a Bachelor of Arts in Pre-Dental and History from Dartmouth College in 1977, where he graduated with honors.
